

ABOUT OUR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Our Tucson campus provides therapeutic programs for more than 3,000 children, adults & families each year.

It is time to renovate our Day Time Activity Program for members with intellectual & developmental disabilities, allowing us to increase accessibility, functionality and capacity.

We will also renovate the central courtyard, allowing us to add new therapeutic spaces for youth behavioral health services.

DAYTIME ACTIVITY PROGRAM

Our Day Time Activity program for adults with disabilities utilizes a person-centered approach, emphasizing independent living skills, implementing therapy plans and social/leisure activities to foster community involvement.

· Durable flooring that can handle the wear and tear caused by wheel chairs.

Our Day Time Activity Program currently serves 39 people; after renovations, we will be able to expand by 30% to serve 50 people.

EMA KAMMEYER COURTYARD

A shaded courtyard will enable us to utilize the natural environment for therapy and recreation. The courtyard will be named for Ema Kammeyer, who was EBF's CEO from 1984-2021.

- Wheelchair-accessible garden beds
- Sensory path
- Play and nature based therapy areas

Sensory paths are a creative and playful way for children with disabilities like autism to develop motor skills such as balance, hand-eye coordination, and spatial awareness, building stronger sensory connections.




