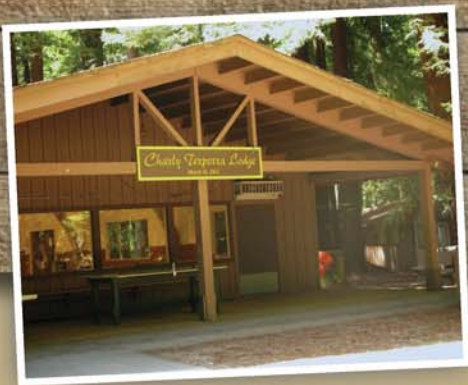

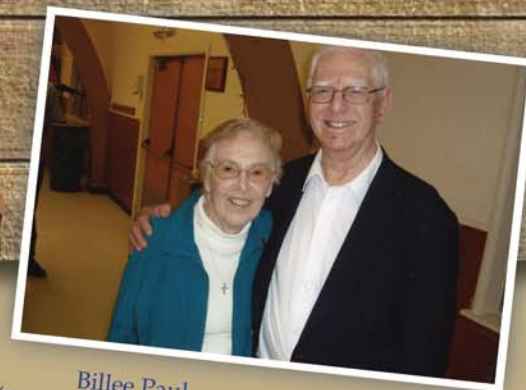

Remember and Restore Campaign

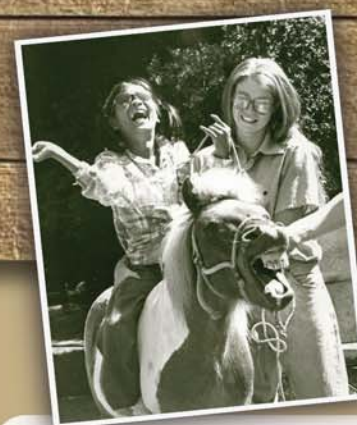
