This camp is open to those enrolled in Southwestern City Schools for children between the elementary school ages of kindergarten completion through 11 years old. The average day at camp focuses on S.T.E.M., reading, math, social activities, artistic expression, and physical education to help prevent the “summer slump”. The best part? Thanks to the Franklin County Commissioners this camp is absolutely **free!**

Youth Summer Camp Quick Facts

- That’s right, **no tuition cost** to families, and priority is given to those who qualify for TANF benefits—SNAP, cash assistance, etc.
- A nutritious **lunch and snacks are provided** daily, at no cost
- Campers **must have completed Kindergarten** to be eligible
- **Bussing will be provided** to and from camp each day for families living within a 3-4 mile radius of the school
- **Weekly Field Trips!**



- Children have **2 hours of academics and 2 hours of physical activity** each day!
- **1:10 staff/student ratios**
- Enrollment packets available soon, packets must be completed for your child to participate in camp.
