- TEAMS MUST STAY TOGETHER.
- TO BE ABLE TO RECORD A FISH, BOTH TEAM MEMBERS MUST SEE IT RELEASED.
- FISHING STARTS AROUND 9:30 AM, SCORE CARDS MUST BE HANDED IN BY 2:45 PM.
- SCORE CARD WILL BE HANDED OUT THE DAY OF THE EVENT, CARD MUST BE FILLED OUT WITH TEAM NAME AND PARTICIPANTS NAMES TO QUALIFY
