Dear Rocky Mountain Village Campers, Families, Caregivers & Host Home Providers,

Rocky Mountain Village is excited to announce that we are now doing camp registration through an online registration called CampDoc. To access the 2018 Summer Camp Application please use the following link: [app.campdoc.com/register/eastersealsco](http://app.campdoc.com/register/eastersealsco). The link will be open for registration on: **Friday, December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018**. By moving to an electronic registration system we are accomplishing the following:

1. All information will be saved electronically and can be reviewed by the family/caregiver/host home provider each year without having to start over.
2. Easy to use interface. We will be able to assist you with any questions along the way.
3. All communication, paperwork deadlines and forms will be streamlined through the new online registration platform called CampDoc.
4. Families/caregivers/host home providers can log into their account and see what forms are still outstanding and which have been completed.
5. Most importantly, all of the above will save you time in your busy life when it's time to apply to camp each year!

### **Helpful Tips:**

1. Google Chrome or Firefox are the recommended web browsers. (Updating your browser may be necessary). This online system cannot be viewed through Internet Explorer.
2. RMV Summer Camp sessions will each cost \$900.00 this year. The deposit will be \$200.00. After making the \$200.00 deposit this will leave a balance of \$700.00.
  - a. Payments can be made by credit card, check or through Community Center Boards (CCB). If payment is not received within 10 days of submitting application online, registration will be placed on hold and will implicate acceptance to camp until payment is received.
3. Through the online registration system there will be a Protection Plan offered. This is not required by RMV to attend camp and is offered through a 3<sup>rd</sup> party.
4. Due to increased demand of people wanting to attend summer camp we are accepting each camper to their first choice session - please only apply to one summer camp session per camper.
5. If a camper requires an Epi-Pen due to allergies, you are required to bring the Epi-Pen to RMV.
6. You do not need to complete the Medical Form or any additional Protocols (Asthma, Seizure, Behavior or Feeding Protocols) until accepted into summer camp.

- July 22- July 27:** Talking with Technology (contact Colo. Children's Hospital if interested)
