Dear Rocky Mountain Village Campers, Families, Caregivers & Host Home Providers,

On <u>Tuesday, December 18th, 2018 at 12:00PM/Noon</u> the 2019 RMV Camper Application will be available and registration will begin!! To access the 2019 Summer Camp Application please use the following link: app.campdoc.com/register/eastersealsco. (You must type the website address exactly how it appears here)

IMPORTANT MEDICAL CHANGES FOR 2019:

- 1. Parent/Caregiver/Guardian will be inputting the medications (medication name, dosage, time to administer) into CampDoc directly under the section labeled "Health Form / Medications"
 - a. We choose to start using CampDoc in two phases last year we wanted to get everyone acquainted with the new system and this year we will be implementing the medical portion of CampDoc that we did not use last year. The main reason for this change is to continue to ensure camper safety when it comes to administering medications. Once the medications are typed into CampDoc, you will print that list and then a doctor will have to sign off confirming those medications are correct. The signed list of medications will then need to be uploaded into CampDoc.
- 2. The Medical Form will look shorter than in years past as many questions have been merged into the application & there is no longer a spot to hand-write medications in. You will need to print the two page Medical Form and bring it to the doctors to be filled out & signed. The signed Medical Form will then need to be uploaded into CampDoc.
- 3. To clarify: There will be two documents to bring to the doctor to sign: The two page Medical Form and the Medication list that will be produced after typing the campers' medications into CampDoc.
 - a. After obtaining a doctors signature on both documents, they will need to be uploaded to CampDoc.
- 4. The Over-the Counter Medication Form will no longer be a paper form but has been digitalized through CampDoc now. You will choose yes or no for each OTC medication just as you would have on the older paper version of the OTC Form.
- 5. Immunization If the camper is under 21 years old, submitting of a copy of the campers immunization record is required.

Helpful Tips:

- 1. Google Chrome or Firefox are the recommended web browsers. (Updating your browser may be necessary). This online system cannot be viewed through Internet Explorer.
- 2. RMV Summer Camp sessions will each cost \$950.00 for 2019. The deposit will be \$200.00. After making the \$200.00 deposit this will leave a balance of \$750.00.
 - a. CampDoc will not charge your card when you enter it. After an official acceptance is made, RMV will access the stored card information on CampDoc and will charge those cards accordingly at Rocky Mountain Village.



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- 3. Through the online registration system there will be a Protection Plan offered. This is not required by RMV to attend camp and is offered through a 3rd party. You may choose to purchase this Protection Plan or you may deny it. Denying the Protection Plan does not affect the campers' registration or acceptance to RMV.
- 4. Due to increased demand for summer camps we will only be accepting one camper to one summer camp session. Please only apply to one summer camp session per camper.
- 5. If a camper requires an Epi-Pen due to allergies, you are required to bring the Epi-Pen to RMV.
- 6. You do not need to complete the Medical Form, the Medication list or any additional Protocols (Asthma, Seizure, Behavior or Feeding Protocols) until officially accepted into a summer camp session.
