PROGRAM REMINDERS

MASKING REQUIREMENTS: The NRADP continues to adhere to the Community Levels of Jefferson County and follow the masking requirements listed below:

> Community Level HIGH: Masks REQUIRED Community Level MEDIUM: Masks REQUIRED Community Level LOW: Masks OPTIONAL
