# MOVING FORWARD: To Mask or Not to Mask?

As mentioned in August's Newsletter, the Neurological Rehabilitation Adult Day Program is exclusively following the instructions set forth by the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment 17th Revised Public Health Order (PHO) 20-38. This order states that all masking requirements are now tied to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC's) county-based COVID-19 Community Level tool.

# Based on this tool, the NRADP will adhere to the Community Levels of Jefferson County and follow the masking requirements listed below:

- Community Level High
- Community Level Medium
- Community Level Low
