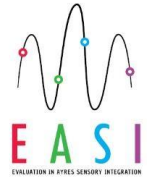

What is the EASI?

The Evaluation in Ayres Sensory Integration is a new set of 20 standardized tests for children ages 3-12 designed to measure:

- Sensory Perception
- Praxis
- Ocular, Postural, and Bilateral Motor Integration
- Sensory Reactivity



The test manual, test sheets, and forms will be available for free to those with training.

Online scoring will be made available to professionals trained in programs that meet ICEASI standards.
