Meet Mason



When Mason and his family's experience with Early Intervention began, he had just been diagnosed with spinal muscular

atrophy type 3, a hereditary disease that affects the nerve cells in the brain stem and spinal cord that control voluntary muscle activity such as speaking, walking, breathing and swallowing. Mason's mom Tori says she and her husband felt powerless and afraid when they first learned about his diagnosis, but Easter Seals helped turn their fear into power. She attributes Mason's tremendous growth in communication skills to both the exceptional therapy he receives each week from Easter Seals and to the parent coaching integrated into each session, empowering Tori and her family to support Mason's development in daily life.
