

AMENDMENT TO 2017-2020 PROVIDER AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE 2017-20 PROVIDER AGREEMENT (the "Amendment") is made and entered into by and between **EASTER SEALS FLORIDA, INC.**, a Florida not-for-profit corporation ("Treasure Coast Early Steps Program" or "TCES") and _____ ("Early Steps Provider Agency" or "Provider"). The Effective Date of this Amendment is _____, 20__.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, TCES and Provider did heretofore enter into that certain 2017-20 Provider Agreement ("Agreement") for the provision of early intervention services and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and obligations between the parties under the Agreement, TCES and Provider do hereby wish to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The Provider and any subcontractors agree to comply with the Pro-Children Act of 1994, Public Law 103-277, which requires that smoking not be permitted in any portion of any indoor facility used for the provision of federally funded services to children up to age 18. Failure to comply with the provisions of the law may result in the imposition of civil monetary administrative compliance order on the responsible entity.
2. The relationship of the parties shall be an independent contractor relationship and not an agency, employment, joint venture, or partnership relationship. Neither party shall have the power to bind the other party or contract in the name of the other party. All persons employed by a party in connection with operations under the Provider Agreement shall be considered employees of that party and shall in no way, neither directly nor indirectly be considered employees of the other party.
3. In accordance with 2 CFR Part 200 Subpart F, Uniform Administrative Requirements, the provider has been determine to be a Recipient/Sub recipient.
 - a. Federal Resources Awarded to the sub recipient pursuant to this agreement consist of the following: Special Education Grants Infants & Families with Disability; CFDA # 84.181; Idea Part C
 - b. Compliance requirements applicable to the federal resources awarded pursuant to this agreement are as follows: U.S. Department of Education – Individual with Disabilities Education Act, Part C
 - c. In the event the Provider expends a total amount of Federal awards equal to or in excess of the threshold established by 2 CFR Part 200, Subpart F - Audit Requirements, the Provider must have a Federal single or program-specific audit conducted for such fiscal year in accordance with the provisions of 2 CFR Part 200, Subpart F - Audit Requirements. In determining Federal awards expended in a fiscal year, the Provider must consider all sources of Federal awards.
 - d. In connection with the audit requirements, the Provider shall fulfill the requirements relative to the auditee responsibilities as provided in 2 CFR Part 200, Subpart F - Audit Requirements.
4. Except to the extent expressly modified by this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unmodified and the Agreement otherwise remains and continues in full force and effect.
