## Our Programs

### Comprehensive Pediatric Therapy

We work with preschoolers starting at age 3, school-aged children, and teenagers with needs relating to: autism, cerebral palsy, developmental delay, learning disability, fine and visual motor delay, articulation, language skills, balance and gait.

### Comprehensive Adult Therapy

We work with adults of all ages who are recovering from injuries, surgery, or illness. We also work with autistic adults as well as those who have developmental disability, intellectual disability, dementia, mental and psychiatric illness among others.

### Stroke & Traumatic Brain Injury Services

Our multidisciplinary approach addresses the diverse needs of individuals on the path to recovery. Our team, comprised of physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, and behavioral health collaborates seamlessly to provide comprehensive care. Our program incorporates cognitive rehabilitation, adaptive skills training, interventions to enhance motor function, and specialized support for addressing communication challenges. We believe it's crucial to support and educate patient's families and caregivers throughout the recovery process. By tailoring interventions to each individual, we aim to optimize functional outcomes, promoting recovery, independence, and an improved quality of life for individuals with a stroke or TBI.

### Dementia Services

Our goal is to provide you with a toolbox of strategies that can help make everyday life calmer, safer, and more fulfilling. We use a wide range of approaches in collaboration with family/caregivers to promote your loved one's participation in meaningful activities and maximize independence.

### Autism Services & PEERS®

We help patients of all ages with their communication, social skills, fine motor skills, gross motor skills, activities of daily living, and sensory regulation. We now offer social skills groups for young adults and teens based on PEERS®, an evidence-based curriculum developed at UCLA. Groups are held in person for weeks at a time, and applications are accepted on an on-going basis.

### Physical Therapy

Our physical therapists treat various conditions resulting from injury, stroke, traumatic brain injury, imbalance, falls, weakness, difficulty walking, pain and after orthopedic surgery. We strive to improve the patient's safety, maximize function and improve their mobility through education, prescribed exercises, manual therapy and modalities as needed.

### Occupational Therapy

Our occupational therapists work with individuals of all ages including but not limited to those with autism, intellectual disability, stroke, and injuries or other problems of the upper body. Occupational therapy can address concerns with a variety of difficulties, including fine motor skills, activities of daily living, sensory processing, and strengthening and range of motion.

### Speech Therapy

Our speech-language pathologists treat patients of all ages with a wide range of diagnoses and needs, including autism, speech articulation, expressive and receptive language, problems with cognition and memory, aphasia, dysarthria, and difficulty swallowing.

### Neuropsychology

Our neuropsychologists specialize in the assessment of individuals with dysfunctions resulting from brain injury, concussion, autism, chemotherapy, memory loss, and more.

## Counseling, Therapy & Case Management

Our licensed clinical social workers provide mental health services for the prevention and treatment of mental, behavioral, and emotional problems. Case management services are also available to assist with program and resource accessibility.
