## **Equipment Loan**

Equipment Loan provides refurbished durable medical equipment -- such as wheelchairs, electric hospital beds, commodes and bath benches -- to individuals in need, at a low cost. Equipment is available by application and requires a prescription from a medical professional prior to obtaining the equipment. Access an application online at www.easterseals.com/ia/at.

Although there is no limit to the amount of time clients may use the equipment, clients are asked to return the equipment when they no longer need it.

The Equipment Loan program operates solely through donations of quality, durable medical equipment. We accept items in good to excellent condition.
