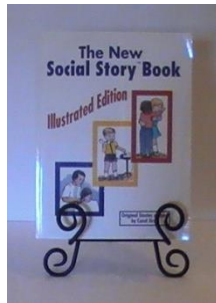




Photo Feelings Fun Book

2011.811

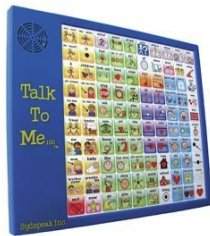
This switch is colorful and provides motivation to touch and make choices. (Image to left)

Interactive tool for children who are learning to talk, or have difficulty with verbal expression. By pressing the button, paired with an image, the message will be vocalized. (Image to left)



Speech Adjust-A-Tone

Device attaches to phone to adjust the bass and treble as well as volume of the sound through the receiver. (Image to left)



Mobile Text Scanner

2011.819

This hand-held device can scan and store up to 500 pages of text. The stored material can be transferred to a PC with a USB connection. Notes are fully editable on the Pen or PC. (Image to left)
