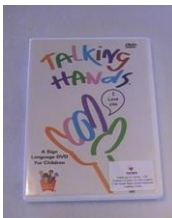
Place your pictures into this photo album and then you can record a message on each page about the picture or event that was happening. Great for learning names with faces. (Image to left)

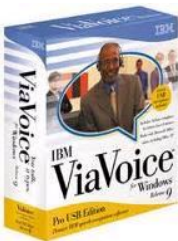
