

Dear Treasured Campers and Camper Families,

It is with a very heavy heart that I write to you today. While we never imagined that the impacts of the COVID19 pandemic would stretch into the summer months, we know now that our plans for Camp Sunnyside summer programming will be impacted. This week we made the difficult decision to cancel our traditional camp season.

The health and safety of our campers has always and will always be our most critical priority. We know what camp means to you. For our campers it means time with friends, fun and exciting new experiences, and memories that last a lifetime. For families, it means knowing your loved one is having a great time while you get a break from caregiving. This decision was not made lightly, however given the highly contagious nature of this virus, the health conditions of our campers and the inability to guarantee the recommended social distancing, we believe this is the best way to ensure everyone's safety.

All fees and registration will be reimbursed. If you paid any registration or fees you will receive a check from Easterseals in the mail no later than June 1, 2020. If you have noticed your check has not cleared the bank, it is because we stopped processing early on in the pandemic, and you will receive your original check back through the mail.

We do have some limited programming options available to you. All groups will be under 10 persons at this time. We will regularly assess and adjust as needed.

Option 1

Expanded small group child care for children with and without disability ages 6-12 -This program will run Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Extended hours may be available on request. Activities will include some traditional camp favorites like sing along's, paddle boats, fishing, rock climbing and nature trails. Option 2

Small group respite for teens with disability- This program will run Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Extended hours may be available on request. Activities will include some traditional camp favorites like sing along's, paddle boats, fishing, rock climbing and nature trails. Option 3

Supported Community Living- this is a skill-building program and is designed to meet the individual needs of each client. Skills may include laundry, cooking, meal planning, problem solving and developing/practicing social skills. This service is available for children and adults.
