This ticket is issued under the Ticket to Work program to help in returning to work. We offer this ticket to an Employment Network (EN) or to your State vocational rehabilitation agency. You can choose an Employment Network (EN) or if you choose you can use these providers can help you go to work.

An Employment Network (EN) is a provider in the Social Security Administration's Employment Network if you assign an EN to help you go to work. An EN must agree to abide by the terms of its agreement for providing services. We will tell you about its rules.

What is the Ticket Program?

The Ticket to Work Program is an innovative program for individuals with disabilities who want to work. It increases your available choices when obtaining employment services, vocational rehabilitation services, and other support services you may need to get or keep a job. It is a free and voluntary service. You can use the Ticket if you choose, but there is no penalty for not using it. While you are using the Ticket, the Social Security Administration (SSA) will not conduct a continuing disability medical review of your case.

How Does the Program Work for You?

The Ticket Program is flexible and voluntary. Beneficiaries receiving Tickets can contact one or more Employment Networks (EN), such as New Frontiers Employment Services, to discuss services; and, once an agreement between you and the EN is reached, the two of you develop a work plan to assist you in reaching your employment goal.
