Kendra's Success Story

New Frontiers Employment Services (NFES) staff began working with Kendra Kirkwood in December 2012. She had no work experience when she first started services, but participated in a job trial that showed she had the initiative and abilities to work in an integrated community work setting. She was first placed in March 2013 as a Substitute Kitchen Helper. That position was uncertain since the possibility existed that she would be called in at the last minute when a full time employee could not come in. Because of the uncertainty, she did not do well in this first work opportunity. In the fall of 2013, with continued assistance from NFES staff, she obtained a positon as a Utility/Dishwasher employed by Sodexo at the University of Southern Indiana (USI). NFES staff worked closely with Kendra and with Sodexo staff to ensure that Kendra understood her job duties and the work environment. Staff also kept in close contact with Sodexo staff to ensure that any issues or concerns were addressed quickly. As a result of these efforts, Kendra is still employed today at Sodexo during the regular school year. During the summers, Kendra works at Holiday World. Her job coach also works with Kendra and the Holiday World staff to ensure that, this too, is a positive work experience for Kendra.

In the beginning, Kendra was very unsure of herself and very anxious about work. It took many months and a great amount of job coaching to get her to the point where she is now more self-confident and is an asset to Sodexo. This fall 2015 semester she moved from her Utility/Dishwashing positon to working the front counter, serving food to the USI students. She now earns \$9.69 per hour and gets a discount on food, something she truly enjoys. She has blossomed and is happy and smiling every day at work. Her self-confidence increases every week. Her family and her employer are very pleased with her positive strides and so is she.

This semester Kendra was nominated for, and received, "An Exceptional Award" for service above and beyond expectation to USI employees, staff and students. She will also be nominated for a November Employee of the Month award with the hope that she will go on to the regional level for this distinction. Kendra is the first employee with special needs to be nominated for these awards.

Thanks to the great team of Kendra and her Employment Specialist/Job Coach Donna Kohlmeyer, this young woman has blossomed into the exceptional employee for Sodexo at USI. Keep up the great work!


