Did you know that *all* children benefit when kids with *and* without disabilities share an inclusive learning environment? That's why all three of the Easterseals Rehabilitation Center's early childhood programs are now together in one inclusive location!

Exciting changes happened on the first day of the school year, when the Dan & Nancy Mitchell Therapeutic Preschool (previously at 3701 Bellemeade) relocated to join other programs at the newly updated **Easterseals Early Learning Center**. That location at **621 S. Cullen Avenue** in Evansville is now the home of:

- **Milestones Early Care** for children of all abilities, 6 weeks-3 years of age
- **LEAD Academy** (Learn, Engage, Achieve, Discover), an inclusive preschool with a wide ranging educational curriculum for children of all abilities, age 3-6
- **Mitchell Therapeutic Preschool** for children age 3-5 identified as having a developmental disability requiring special education services

# 25th Ritzy's Fantasy of Lights shines Nov. 22-Jan. 1!

## Popular 5K run & family fun walk returns Wed., Nov. 28!

It's the 25th year for Ritzy's Fantasy of Lights—a beloved holiday tradition that raises therapy funds for Easterseals! The show will brighten Evansville's Garvin Park nightly from Thanksgiving (Nov. 22) through New Year's Day (Jan. 1). *On Nov. 28 ONLY, no vehicles will be admitted, as the event welcomes runners and walkers to the "Bright Lights for Easterseals" 5K run and family fun walk!*

The drive-through display features 62 elaborate lighted scenes. Animation gives the illusion of movement to many exhibits. **More displays will be transformed with LED lights this year, so the event will shine brighter than ever!**

Hours are 5-9 p.m. Sun.-Thur. and 5-10 p.m. Fri. and Sat. Tickets are available at the gate OR in advance from any Ritzy's in Evansville. Admission per vehicle remains at the same affordable price: Up to 6 people \$7; 7-14 people \$10; 15 or more people \$25. Visitors may choose a horse-drawn carriage ride (weather permitting) for \$30, which includes admission; no reservations are needed.

## Kids learn life lessons with *Tools 4 Teaching* presents “Easterseals Hop-N-Ing!”

Kids have fun *and* learn valuable life lessons with **Tools 4 Teaching** presents “Easterseals HOP-N-ING!” The week-long disability awareness program can be used *at no cost* by elementary teachers any time during the school year, or year-round for preschools and other groups.

**Materials include a curriculum guide and five dolls with disabilities.** Their stories help students develop a better understanding of people with differing abilities. **Last year, a doll named James, depicting a child with autism, joined four other dolls with more visible disabilities.**

Easterseals staff can present HOP-N-ING information to groups, classes, or in an assembly setting. Groups can also tour the Easterseals Rehabilitation Center to see how our services enable people with disabilities to live, learn, work, and play independently.

After learning about disabilities, children help to change lives *and* win prizes by collecting pledges for each hop completed during a 3-minute HOP-N-ING. Money raised provides therapy for local kids and adults.
