girl had so many challenges. Ella was born with a
cleft palate, heart murmur, bilateral hearing loss,
hiatal hernia, and enlarged esophagus. She has a
global developmental delay, as well as ADHD and
vision issues. Thankfully, Easterseals became a part
of our journey from the very beginning!



Ella received Easterseals therapies at our home from birth to age 3. With that help **she reached developmental milestones that most families take for granted, like sitting, crawling, smiling, reaching, grasping, and standing**. Ella also received her first hearing aids from Easterseals before she was 18 months old. They opened a new door to learning! **Ella began thriving with the help of generous friends like YOU!** 

From age 3 to 5, Ella <u>flourished</u> in the Easterseals Rehabilitation Center's Mitchell Therapeutic Preschool. She learned skills she would need for kindergarten, while progressing in daily therapy sessions.

I'm so proud that she "graduated" from physical and occupational therapy! **Easterseals** is still a big part of Ella's life—and mine—as she keeps working to speak more clearly and improve her social skills. 
