# **Food Fun**

### Kid-Size Pizza

Need a last minute snack for the kids after the pool or playing outside? Here is the perfect kid-friendly recipe for bite-sized pizzas. Add in an additional topping or two if you'd like!

#### **Ingredients**

- 2 tubes (7-1/2 ounces each) refrigerated buttermilk biscuits
- 1 can (8 ounces) tomato sauce
- 1-1/2 teaspoons dried minced onion
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1 teaspoon dried basil
- 1/8 teaspoon garlic powder
- 2 cups shredded part-skim mozzarella cheese



#### **Directions**

- Roll or pat biscuits into 2-1/2 in. circles. Place on greased baking sheets.
- In a small bowl, combine the tomato sauce, onion, oregano, basil and garlic powder; spread over the biscuits. Sprinkle with cheese. Bake at 400° for 8-10 minutes or until edges are lightly browned.

# **Health and Safety**

Trying to save on the electric bill and opening up the windows? Kids playing outside on the deck or balcony of your home? Here are some tips on how to prevent injuries at windows & balconies:

- Secure all windows with window restrictors that do not require tools for opening.
- Keep furniture away from windows. This includes cots, beds, seats, tables, boxes etc. a Keep objects that a child can use to stand or climb on away from windows and balconies.
- Get rid of gaps in balcony railings that could be used as a foothold or that children could fit through.
- X Do <u>not</u> fit blinds and curtains with cords attached if already fitted make them safer:
  - Use a tie down or tension device to pull the cord tight and secure it to the floor or wall or
  - Replace cords with curtain or blind wands, out of children's reach.
