This year we launched a very special program. PEERS provides social skills training to adolescents with Autism and related disorders. In 2017, we completed three PEERS classes. Witnessing the growth in these teens over the 14 week PEERS classes and hearing the testimonials of their parents has been a profound experience for all of us at Easterseals. Because of your support, these teens are able to navigate social situations and develop friendships.

Another project that we are very proud to have been a part of in 2017 was an initiative through the Louisiana Department of Health which provided screenings to all individuals on the Medicaid Waiver Request for Services Registry list. Many of these individuals have been waiting for services for years due to state budget limitations. Through this project, we screened 1077 individuals. This work helped to determine actual needs and in fact, facilitated immediate services for those in critical need.

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

LIVE

supportive housing

Provides a safe and comfortable environment for people with behavioral health, substance abuse, or co-occurring disorders with the ultimate goal of independent living.

support coordination

Assists disabled children, adults, and the elderly and individuals with behavioral health issues in accessing needed services to increase their independence.

crisis services

Assists in reducing the use of hospitalizations or visits to the emergency room through the delivery of immediate community based treatments and interventions for families in crises.

intensive community engagement

Moves homeless individuals or households from the streets or homeless shelters into their own apartment, using the Housing First Principles.

LEARN

community psychiatric support treatment services (cpst)

Provides goal-directed support and solution focused interventions, which are intended to assist individuals achieve objectives.

psychosocial rehabilitation services (psr)

Assists individuals with integration as an active and productive member of the community, with the least amount of ongoing supports or interventions.

peers training

Helps teens with Autism learn how to make friends.

earlysteps- system point of entry (spoe)

Identifies, evaluates, and supports infants and toddlers, ages birth to 3, who may have developmental disabilities.

employment resource & referral Offers a range of resources that help prepare individuals for the work force.

PLAY

campership

Provides funding for summer camp tuition for children and young adults with disabilities.

ACT

community engagement

Support from a network of volunteers, advocates, donors and vendors who assist us in sustaining our mission.

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


