<p>Precautionary Measures/ Quarantine (per professional order)</p>	<p>Staff will immediately report if they or someone in their household has been ordered to quarantine or if quarantine has been recommended as a precautionary measure.</p>	<p>Staff to notify immediate supervisor</p> <p>Supervisor will immediately notify via email Darryl Kimble, Ben Plawsky, and Director</p> <p>The taskforce will be updated at least weekly</p>
<p>Possible contact with a symptomatic person or confirmed COVID-19</p>	<p>If staff or someone in their household is symptomatic or has been in possible direct contact with someone who has been diagnosed, they are to report it and quarantine immediately.</p>	<p>Staff to notify immediate supervisor</p> <p>Supervisor will immediately notify via email Darryl Kimble, Ben Plawsky, and Director</p> <p>The taskforce will be updated at least weekly</p>
<p>Displaying Symptoms/ Feeling ill</p>	<p>Any staff displaying symptoms should report it and not report to work. Staff must be symptom-free for 24 hours (no temp, fever, cough) before possibly able to return. If they are displaying multiple symptoms or symptoms worsen after three days, we suggest staff seek medical attention. If staff are out longer than three days, their absence follows FMLA protocol.</p>	<p>Staff to notify immediate supervisor</p> <p>Supervisor will immediately notify via email Darryl Kimble, Ben Plawsky, and Director</p> <p>The taskforce will be updated at least weekly</p>
<p>Testing/ Confirmed COVID-19 status</p>	<p>Staff should remain in contact with management, and if you or someone in your household is being tested, you need to alert your management team immediately. When the results come back, they will need to be submitted to benefits showing clearance before staff may return.</p>	<p>Staff to notify Immediate supervisor</p> <p>Supervisor will immediately notify via email Darryl Kimble, Ben Plawsky, and Director</p> <p>The taskforce will be updated at least weekly.</p>
