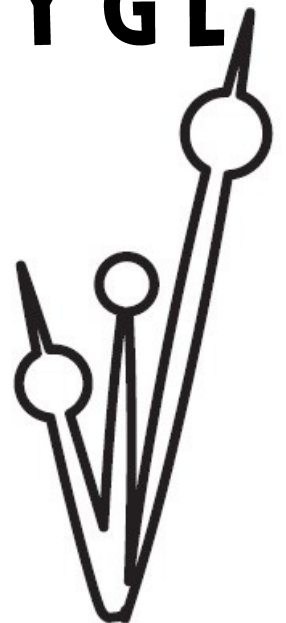

- problem solving skills, leading to greater academic outcomes.

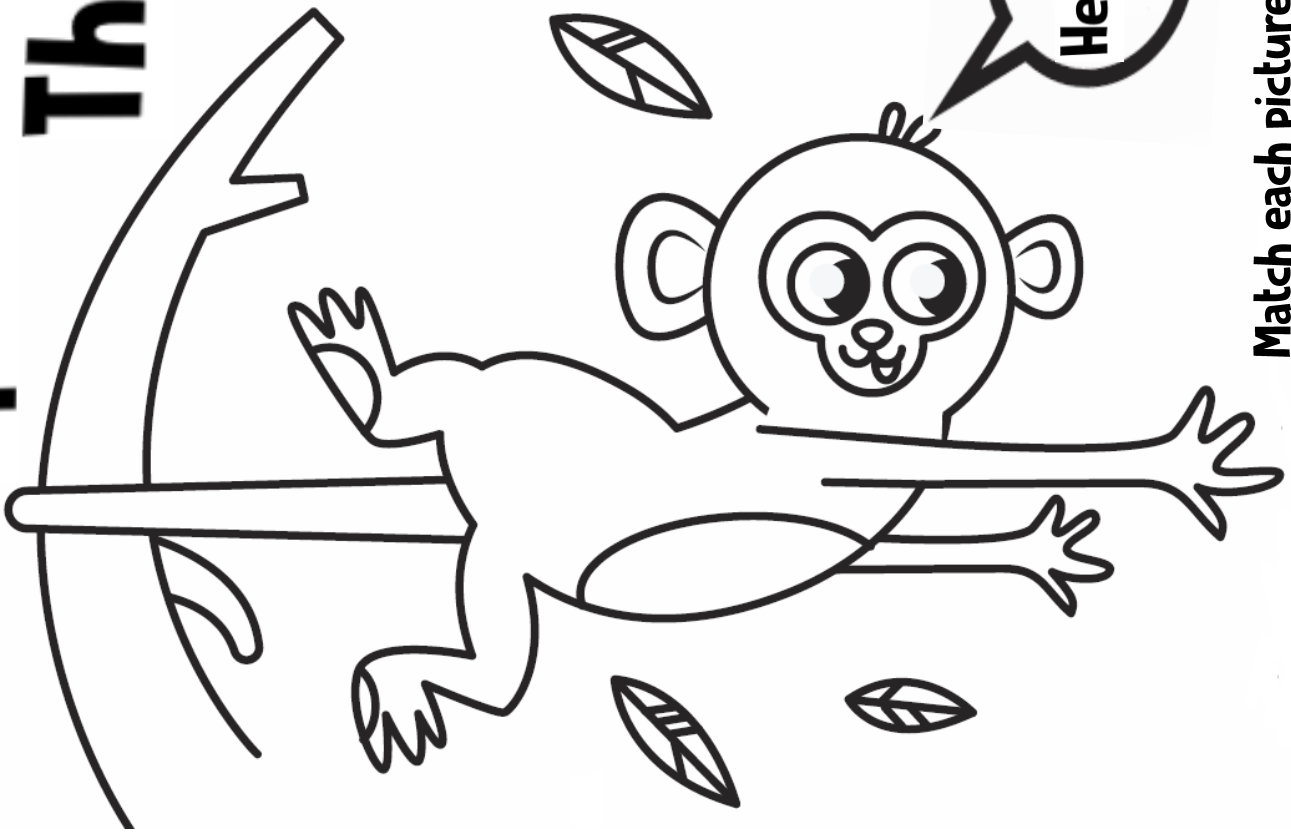

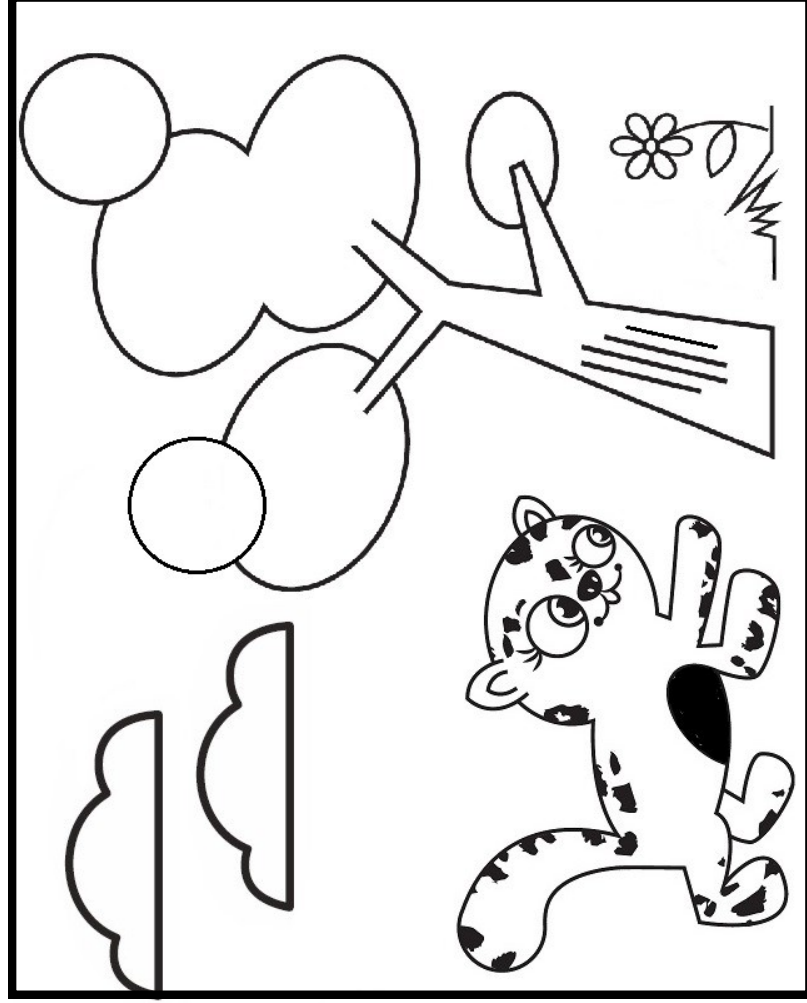
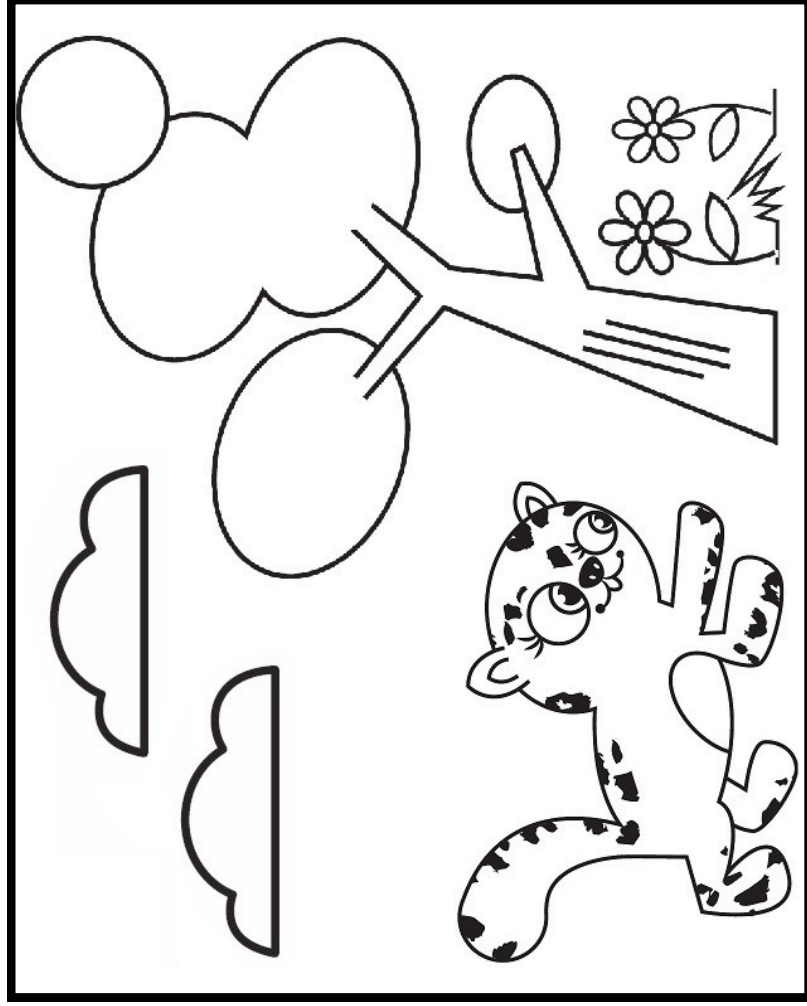


Physical therapists help people learn to move in, out, and within their environments. They work on activities to improve balance, coordination, strength, endurance, mobility, and sports skills.

# Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA)

Applied behavior analysis (ABA) is an evidence-based science that uses principles of learning to change behaviors of social significance. The therapists who practice ABA, called Board Certified Behavior Analysts, use these principles to teach new skills and appropriate alternatives for challenging behavior. ABA is the standard of care for the treatment of Autism.

Our Outpatient Rehabilitation provides clinic-based treatment. We provide high-quality services for our clients in both individual and group sessions. We offer:

- evidence-based therapy;

In addition to PT, OT, and ST services, we also provide social skills group and Club Easterseals— our after-school program for teens focused on building independence and friendships.

### **APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS (ABA)**

We provide Applied Behavior Analysis therapy to children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. We offer a variety of options to fit the needs of each family. Parent and caregiver training is provided as a part of all ABA programs. We collaborate closely with experts from the Department of Behavior Analysis at the University of North Texas to ensure our programs provide evidence-based services and to help conduct research to continually improve services.

#### **Child Development Program**

**Ages 12 months-6 years**

**Location: Carrollton**

- Up to 32 hours of direct services per week.
- Children with ASD learn alongside typically developing peers.
- ABA services provide intensive treatment in language, engagement, and social skills.

#### **Comprehensive Services**

**Ages 2-7 years**

**Locations: Carrollton and Fort Worth**

- 24 hours of direct services per week.
- One-on-one instruction in individual and group settings focusing on all developmental areas including communication, socialization, fine motor, gross motor, play, and daily living skills.

#### **Focused Services**

**Ages 2-15 years**

**Locations: Carrollton and Fort Worth**

- Daytime and after-school sessions offer 6-12 hours of one-on-one services per week.
- Programming targets core deficits and focuses 2 to 3 primary domains for each child.
