



Dear Participants, Parents, & Care Providers,

Easterseals Adult Day Services (ADS) are continuing to closely monitor the coronavirus (now named COVID-19) developments and have been working with county and state health officials to establish protocols for our services to focus on stopping the spread of COVID-19. We have been very active in our response at specific Adult Day Services locations.

The nature of our services has always been social with a strong emphasis on being an active part of our local communities. Taking this into account, and the potential medical vulnerability of the people we serve, it is with a heavy heart that we have decided to suspend all Adult Day Services beginning Monday, March 16th, through to at least March 27th, 2020. The closure may be longer depending how this health crisis continues to unfold.

As we develop, modify and enact our plan, your best contact for information will continue to be the Director for the ADS you attend. More information will be shared as this plan develops. In the meantime, current information about the coronavirus is available on the [CDC](#) website and through your local county Health Department websites that can help you personally decrease your risk of contracting COVID-19.
