

Bryce Epstein MD

Dr. Epstein has been living in South Florida since 1960. After finishing his training in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation in 1990, he joined the Orthopedic Care Center in Aventura, where he remains a partner. He was Chairman of the Department of Rehabilitation at Parkway Regional Medical Center from 1992-2006, and Medical Director of Rehabilitation Services at Aventura Hospital 1994-1997. Dr. Epstein joined the Easter Seals Society of South Florida in 1993, and served as Medical Director of Outpatient Services and Scoliosis Clinic. He started the annual charity golf tournament, which is one of the longest running in South Florida, and has been a member of the Board of Directors since 2009. He was the team physician for St. Thomas University 1999-2007. Dr. Epstein was the Medical Advisor for the World Olympians Association 2003-2006, and a member of the Miami Dade Sports Commission.
