The mission of Easter Seals Child Development Centers is to provide an inclusive and comprehensive early childhood education programs and customized therapy services as needed.

The Child Development Centers provide developmentally appropriate curriculum experiences and activities, and may also provide therapeutic intervention for those children in need of such services.
