

Camp Easter Seals UCP Medication Guidelines

PRE-PACKAGED MEDICATIONS REQUIRED FOR ALL CAMPERS

In an effort to better serve our campers and reduce possible errors in medicine administration we are require all campers to come to camp with pre-package medications. This means that all medications, vitamins, and supplements brought to camp must be prepared in a multi-dose or medication cassette for the duration of their stay. It is preferred that this is done in a “bubble pack” by a pharmacist as seen below.

Medication Cassette can be purchased from your local pharmacy and is packed by camper or caregiver
➤ Original bottles must accompany medications

Whether meds are packed in a bubble pack or medicine cassette:

- All medical containers must be labeled with camper’s name and medicine’s name(s)
- Be separated by day and time taken
- Preferably include only the amount needed plus one extra dose
- Send liquid and powder medications along with topical treatments in their original containers
- If medicine list located on the medical form submitted prior to arrival changes an updated prescription will be needed with a doctor’s signature.

If camper arrives to camp without prepackaged meds they will be required to borrow a cassette from camp and will have to package their meds at this time while moving to the back of the check-in line.
