Easterseals Arkansas Involvement Opportunities

Volunteering in Programs:

- Volunteering in the Preschool – reading to children, assisting teachers with activities, being a playground buddy
- Volunteering at the Children’s Rehabilitation Center – assisting the recreation staff with activities, join the children on field trips, assisting with Miracle League or Special Olympics
- Volunteering at the Center for Training and Wellness (Adult Services) – read in the book club, assist in the Art & Music class, assist in teaching kitchen classes, teach a yoga or Zumba class, assist with resume writing and mock interviews, assist with adult dance once a quarter, drama therapy, A.R.T)
- These all require a time commitment in advance.

Volunteering for Events

- Volunteers are needed for Arkansan of the Year (April 6), The Fashion Event (February 24), Rock Run (May 13), Rollin’ on the River (August 27), Drives for Disabilities (September 19), Bancorp South Charity Classic (October 12 & 13), Greek Food Festival (May 19, 20, 21) and Art & Soul (November 3). Volunteers assist with the logistics of each event in various roles.

Organize a Volunteer Day

- Recruit and organize a team (from work, church, friends, etc.) to volunteer at Easter Seals for a day/morning/afternoon. Projects will be arranged through Breda Turner and the Easter Seals maintenance crew and can range from cleaning/organizing to landscaping/painting depending on the groups abilities and whatever needs to be done.

Organize a Donation Drive

- Coordinate with Easter Seals Development staff to organize and execute a donation drive at your business, church, or other organization. Items may include school supplies, money for therapy equipment, sensory items for sensory rooms, art supplies for A.R.T., supplies for classrooms at the Center for Training and Wellness, canned food at Thanksgiving and/or Christmas, and other needs as determined by ES staff.

Provide Gifts for Children or Adults at Christmas

- The Children’s Rehabilitation Center holds a party for the children each year. Donors provide gifts for the children. Donors do not need to feel obligated to spend more than \$75 per child.
- The Center for Training and Wellness hosts a Christmas Party for our adults each year. Easter Seals’ provides presents costing around \$10 for every adult.

Serve on The Fashion Event Committee/Serve on the Art & Soul Committee

- Committee members begin meeting about six months prior to the event. The Fashion Event is February 24th and Art & Soul is November 3rd. Committee members are heavily involved with the planning and fundraising for the event.

Captain a team for Rollin’ on the River

- Rollin’ is a 5k run/2k Family Fun Walk held at the Clinton Library on August 27th. Teams raise money and awareness for Easter Seals by getting family, friends, and colleagues to join their team. Each team has an ambassador from Easter Seals.
