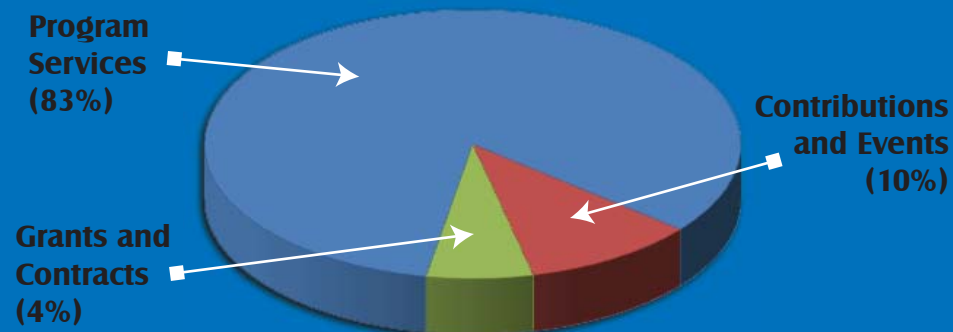

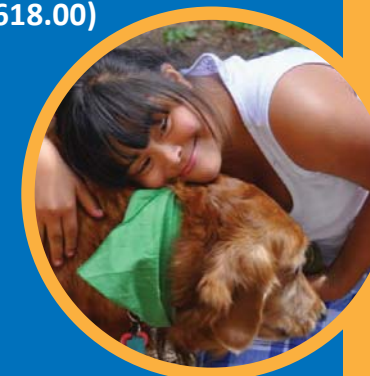

Programs and Services

Autism Services provide early intervention for young children and teaches parents strategies to address challenging behavior and strengthen relationships, as well as autism consultants who provide support in school-based settings.

Camp Harmon inspires campers to reach beyond the limits of their disabilities. Encouraged by staff in a beautiful setting, campers experience healthy outdoor activities, including horseback riding, swimming, arts and crafts, and dancing.

Educational Services help children with disabilities succeed in school with the help of specially trained 1:1 classroom aides, school nurses, health aides, sign language interpreters, behavioral aides and home teaching.



Strengthening Special Families

supports parents of young children with any disability to achieve their maximum potential through home visits and a facilitated group parenting series.

Respite Care provides in-home assistance for families who need support to manage daily activities due to the challenging responsibilities of caring for a loved one with a disability.

Wide Awakes provides regular monthly recreational and social activities for adults with physical and developmental disabilities.
