In 2014, we saw tremendous growth in many of our programs, and I am delighted to share some of those highlights with you.

- In 2014 we impacted more lives and increased the number of families served which includes a rise in the number of veterans receiving services.
- In 2014, the Early Intervention program continued to see great progress. In addition to our pediatric therapies, we implemented a music therapy program and began offering parent workshops to our families and community. These workshops include toilet training and parent's rights in the special education process.
- The Dolly Parton Imagination Library has continued to expand and now includes more counties in southern Ohio including Jackson County where

we have seen a great community need. We continue to enroll children in this program that provides free books every month to children ages birth to five.
