General Purpose:

The Summer Camp Counselor leads the camp program for participants with disabilities. Provides high-quality education and recreational opportunities and enjoyable experiences for camp participants. Supervisors' campers and ensures their safety, development, growth, skill achievement, and general well-being. This work will be performed on-site at Rocky Mountain Village in Empire, CO.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Organizes team games
- Leads activities such as crafts and art, demonstrating various techniques and encouraging children
- Communicates with parents, providing updates where required and answering questions about camp
- Checking on campers with medical needs to ensure they have taken any medication if self-administrating
- Will be responsible for working with the site personnel to ensure a safe and welcoming environment for staff and campers by adhering to all safety guidelines, including but not limited to, the disinfecting and cleaning of all areas used by the camp every day
- Provides guidance, motivation, and supports all camp visitors

Qualifications:

- Certification in CPR/First Aid is required
- Ability to live in Colorado, on-site, for the months of the summer camp season
- Must be able to pass all State and Federal background checks
- Ability and willingness to work in a team environment
- Ability and willingness to communicate effectively in written and verbal formats
