**PURPOSE:** To provide a safe, developmentally appropriate environment that promotes physical, emotional, and intellectual growth for the children in the program.

## **MISSION STATEMENT:**

Our mission is to ensure that children with disabilities and their families are empowered.

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Plan, implement, evaluate and supervise a developmentally appropriate and inclusive educational curriculum for enrolled children.
- 2. Work within a multi-disciplinary framework with therapists, teachers, and support staff to ensure an effective and therapeutic program.
- 3. Serve as case manager/ service coordinator for each child in the classroom.
- 4. Exercise appropriate and positive discipline procedures as established by the Center policy.
- 5. Become knowledgeable with and adhere to all DCFS licensing standards.
- 6. Plan classroom activities in accordance with the philosophies and policies of the Center and best practices.
- 7. Establish, plan for, and utilize instructional methods which motivate and enable each child to achieve learning objectives.
- 8. Consult with therapy staff regarding appropriate intervention techniques related to each discipline (OT, PT, ST).
- 9. Maintain open communication with parents and all other family members.
- 10. Coordinate and supervise bi-monthly classroom meetings.
- 11. Supervise and evaluate teacher's assistants and volunteers in the performance of their duties.
- 12. Actively participate in staff meetings, parent meetings, in-service trainings, and program meetings.
- 13. Coordinate general housekeeping duties, including: preparing snack, feeding children, pottying and diapering children, and general clean up.
- 14. Complete and maintain all other required documentation and records.
- 15. Provide the children with a safe, loving and nurturing environment.
- 16. Develop a cooperative and supportive attitude as a team member.

- 17. Develop newsletters for the parents on a regular basis, including information on classroom activities, child development and overall Center events.
- 18. Maintain a clean and pleasant environment in the classroom, playground and other areas of the program.
- Provide services consistent with established Easter Seals DuPage and the Fox Valley Region Mission, Values, and Philosophy.
- 20. Maintain client confidentiality and respect the rights and dignity of all individuals.
- 21. Adhere to Easter Seals DuPage and the Fox Valley Region Code of Ethics. Comply with all Federal, State and local laws and regulations.
- 22. Participates in other activities that support department and Center projects and goals as requested.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- BA, CCP, CDA, or Associate's degree in Early Childhood with at least six credit hours in child development
- 19 years of age
- Must relate well to children and their families
- Able to lift up to 50 lbs. up to 20 times per day
- As required by DCFS, all employees must possess the following qualities:
  - 1. Emotional maturity when working with children and their families
  - 2. Cooperation with purpose and services of the program
  - 3. Respect for children and adults
  - 4. Compassion, understanding and patience
  - 5. Physical and mental health that do not interfere with job description
  - 6. Good personal hygiene
  - 7. Sensitivity to children's socioeconomic, cultural, ethnic, and religious backgrounds, and individual needs and abilities

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

Unless exempted by the Americans with Disabilities Act, all persons hired for this position are required to perform the following essential functions:

- 1. Lift up to 50 lbs. on an as-needed basis, climb ladders and work overhead
- 2. Perform the basic life operational functions of talking, hearing, vision
- 3. Perform repetitive motions (i.e. computer keying and/or dialing phone)

This position requires exposure to the following environmental factors:

- 1. Daily contact with domestic and industrial cleaners;
- 2. Exposure to variable noise levels;
- 3. Occasional contact with noxious smells;
- 4. Frequent exposure to communicable illnesses
