

Acknowledgement of Receipt COVID-19 Protocols: Summer Camp 2022

Your safety and the safety of all our campers, employees, contractors and volunteers is Easterseals top priority. In light of COVID-19, we are taking additional precautions on top of our long-established health and safety measures to ensure we are mitigating the risk of COVID-19 at camp.

Our mitigation plan includes:

- Pre-attendance education and screening.
- Health screening conducted by families and campers prior to the start of camp, including a temperature check.
- Health screening upon arrival at camp conducted by trained staff.
- Visitors to camp must be approved by Easterseals, complete a screening, and wear a mask while at camp.
- Hygiene reminders throughout the camp experience.
- Handwashing/sanitizing stations throughout camp.
- Staff to clean and disinfect high-touch surfaces and shared program equipment.
- An emergency response plan that includes isolation and quarantine protocol should a person develop symptoms of COVID-19 or other communicable disease while at camp.
- Check-ins with campers 1-2 weeks after the camper's session to determine if any participants have developed symptoms.

These precautions are important, but they do not remove the potential for exposure to COVID-19 or any other illness while at camp. Some people with COVID-19 show no signs or symptoms of illness but can still spread the virus, and people may be contagious before their symptoms occur. These factors mean that an infected person may pass the required health screenings and be admitted into camp.

While every precaution will be taken to maintain social distancing and other safety measures, nothing is foolproof.

We know that each camper, staff member, contractor and volunteer has a unique set of circumstances to consider when deciding whether to attend camp. We hope this information will be helpful as you make those choices.
