Receiving Your Assistive Technology

- This device was sanitized prior to shipping from the Easterseals lowa Assistive Technology Center.
- Upon arrival of the package, please place in an isolated area and allow it to remain there for a minimum of 48 hours.

Opening Your Assistive Technology

- Please sanitize hands and use plastic, disposable gloves to unbox the device and ensure you wash your hands with soap or thoroughly sanitize your hands between opening the box and removing the devices.
- Dispose of the external packaging outside of the home and ensure all surfaces and skin that the box touched are sanitized.

Returning Your Assistive Technology

We ask that you do not return your devices before May 1st, 2020. This is subject to change. If changes are made, your loan will be extended to prevent overdue loans and you will be notified.

Safety and Prevention

Please practice social distancing. Please make sure you are following the precautions that have been shared over the last few weeks:
