HOP-N-ING helps children develop an understanding of disabilities.

The HOP-N-ING curriculum is designed for preschool / elementary students to help them understand what it means for a child to have a disability. HOP-N-ING also explores how to be good friends to someone with a disability.

Schools may reserved the HOP-N-ING materials for any week during the school year. This includes teaching materials, role-playing dolls, and other activities that can easily be incorporated into classroom curriculum. These resources help students develop an understanding about disabilities.



Schools also have the option of scheduling an Easterseals representative to talk with students in a multi-class assembly or taking a field trip to tour the Easterseals Rehabilitation Center.



HOP-N-ING helps people in our community!

As part of the HOP-N-ING program, each student will hop as many times as he or she can in a time period.
