Easter Seals is an enduring resource, providing exceptional services, offering help and hope to today's families confronting disabilities. Services are provided at designated Easter Seals locations, family homes, community, and school sites. More than 3,437 individuals from 82 communities throughout the Region are directly served on an annual basis with countless others benefiting from the work of Easter Seals.

**Early Intervention**

100% of parent respondents reported functional gains for their children.  
401 diagnostic evaluations; developmental screenings enhanced program access.  
80% of service plan goals met by the children.  
98% program satisfaction rating.

**Outpatient Rehabilitation**

82% of goals were met in physical, occupational, and speech therapy.  
100% of families reporting their child benefited from therapy.  
482 diagnostic evaluations  
Racially diverse clients are reflective of Regional demographics.

**School Based Therapy Services**

481 evaluations; 2,9412 consultations  
In-person and virtual learning options.  
Meeting the requirements of the Individualized Education Plan.  
Evidence-based interventions for learning, behavior and social participation.

**Foster Care**

67 children, adolescents and young adults; 41 licensed foster homes.  
In person and virtual visits. Dashboard outcomes exceed state-wide average.  
Administrative case reviews document program satisfaction.  
17 case closings to permanency.

**Residential Services**

65 individuals with developmental disabilities served.  
My25 Nutritional Menu Program improving health status.  
Home & Important Relationships the most selected goal areas.  
Guardians expressed appreciation for safe activities and care during COVID-19.

**Jump Start**

429 children and 322 families with 3,597 personal visits.  
96% of newly enrolled families had an initial assessment within 120 days of enrollment.  
Ninety-two percent of children completed an initial health review.  
Parents report satisfaction in finding useful family resources in their communities.

**Autism Services**

67% of children assessed received a medical diagnosis of Autism.  
Extended phone consultations provided to 360 callers.  
Monthly newsletter distributed in English and Spanish.  
Parents report eam recommendations helpful to the family.

**Behavioral Consultation**

100 % of new cases began services within 30 days.  
Notable reductions in restrictive procedures inclusive of medication reductions.  
90% of parents implementing behavioral techniques.  
Assistance provided on wearing masks, washing hands, and understanding the pandemic.

**Childcare**

40 unique children served; therapies provided on site as needed.  
Rebranded name and logo to Easterseals Regional Early Childhood Center  
Creative Curriculum; Excele Rate Illinois Bronze Circle of Quality.  
Restore Illinois Licensed Daycare Guidance.
